Minimum Qualifications:

- 21 years of age or older
- The Social Worker shall be a licensed social worker, or a licensed independent social worker, or a licensed professional counselor, or a licensed professional clinical counselor,
- Must have a reliable means of transportation for travel within the community.
- Must maintain a valid driver’s license

Responsible To:

- Group Home Director

Specific Responsibilities:

- Create and maintain Service Plan and Behavior Plan with required contra-indicator assessments.
 - Oversee case coordination and case conferences for Consumers.
 - Provide education and training to Group Home Staff and Consumer families.
 - Teach workshops.
 - Review Service Notes and sign off on them before being turned into placing agency
 - Attend meetings as scheduled for clinical staff;
 - Attend monthly Group Home Staff meetings;
 - Assist in ensuring that service notes are in before deadlines and monthly summaries.
 - Assist in processing with Consumer at least once a Month to find out how things are progressing
